

## Transition to Bishopbriggs Academy



There are doors on the left hand side of the building called the **Pupil** entrance that you use to enter the school. If you are late then you should go in the Main entrance and sign in.



When you get inside the school it looks like this.



If you come to school early, you can sit in the pupil area or go to library.





You will be given a locker to use. It will have a *code number* on it, and you will get a *key* to open and lock it. You can leave my things in it during the day.

Your locker will be arranged during your classtime ( PSHE) with your Guidance teacher, a deposit will be required,



You can use the payment machines to put money on your account to pay for your food from canteen.



This is the cafeteria where you can have lunch.



This is school office, you might get asked to take things to school office.



This is the guidance base, you will find your guidance teacher in here.



This is the Learning Support Resource (LSR), you will find Mrs Slavin here.



This is the Wellbeing base, you might attend here for Nurture groups or if you need some support.



You will work in different parts of the school and will have to change classrooms to go to different lessons.

This is a teaching classroom, these are used for Maths, English, Social Subjects and Languages.



This is a Science classroom.



This is a Food and Consumer Science classroom.



This is an ICT classroom, they are mainly used for computing and business management.



This is a Technical classroom.



This is the drama classroom.



This is a music classroom.



This is the Senior Management corridor, this will be where you will find Ms Forsyth.



This is one of the gym halls in the school. It is huge!



There are changing rooms to get changed in before and after gym lessons.

You will go to assembly with all of  $1^{st}$  year.



The Hub is on the  $1^{\rm st}$  floor and used for small group work/tutorials.



The school has three levels:

G = ground floor

F = first floor

5 = second floor

You can use the stairs to go up and down to different floors. Your timetable will tell you which floor to go to and the number of the classroom.

We follow a one way system in the school at certain times Between class times,

Green and yellow stairs are UP stairs

Red and Blue are DOWN stairs.

Before registration, after break and after lunch, all stairs are UP stairs Before break, before lunch and at end of day, all stairs are DOWN stairs.

This does seem confusing but you will get used to it very quickly!!!



You can go outside into the open areas at break times.
