


FURTHER REVIEWS OF THE PLANNER


In session 2012/13 we will consult with pupils in S4-S6 on the sections of the planner that have remained the same with a view to making further improvements.

How to use your planner to assess your progress




HOMEWORK TASKS



ENSURE YOUR PLANNER IS SIGNED

It is essential that you keep your *aims, traffic light assessments* and *homework* up to date. This must be signed by your parent and house tutor <u>every week</u>.



USING THE TRAFFIC LIGHT PAGES TO ASSESS YOUR PROGRESS AND COMMUNICATE THIS TO YOUR TEACHER

Turn to the red page to indicate to the teacher that you are finding a task challenging and require support

Turn to the amber page if you finding the task challenging and may need some further support

Turn to the green page if you are having no difficulties with task and you can make good progress without support
