- Demonstrate safety procedures to all passengers
- Attend to passengers

Career Insight: Hotel Manager

Average Salary: £47, 320 No. Employed: 8,300

This job requires you to oversee the running of an entire hotel in order to ensure guests have the best stay. You will manage staff and use business skills to manage budgets and marketing. Your day-to-day role would depend on the size of the hotel. **You would be expected to**:

- Set budgets
- Analyse information and statistics
- Manage staff, customers and complaints
- Organise maintenance etc

Career Insight: Art Gallery Curator

Average Salary: £22,880

<u>No. Employed</u>: 2, 600 (projected to rise by 15%) This job requires you to organise and create exhibitions in order

to attract visitors to the gallery. You would be expected to provide visitors with information to explain the exhibition and persuade businesses to sponsor your exhibition.

You would be expected to:

- Research and identify objects to feature in your exhibition
- Store artifacts/art work in the correct conditions
- Create catalogues and information packs for visitors
- Give presentations to visitors/answer visitor questions
