Average Salary: £30,680 No. Employed: 10,400

This job requires you to record sound effects, speech or music using specialised equipment. You could be doing this for TV, films, radio, ads or websites. You would need to be able to work flexible, possibly long hours.

You would be expected to:

- Plan recording sessions with various individuals
- · Add sound effects if required
- Mix tracks in order to produce the final product
