## Introduction of Parents Portal

East Dunbartonshire Council is changing the way schools and families communicate with each other through a new online service called **parentsportal.scot**.

This is an online portal designed to be a one-stop shop for a number of school-related activities and will create a new digital relationship between home and school. Through time it is hoped this portal will make communicating with one another easier and more efficient.

At the heart of the system is an online account created by the Scottish Government called **myaccount**. This is a secure method of accessing parentsportal scot which will allow you to link to your child and carry out the following tasks using a single sign-on approach:

- Make online payments (cashless catering)
- Report an absence (note: for Covid-19 absences you should contact the school office direct)
- View pupils' attendance
- View pupils' timetable
- View school holidays
- View school twitter feed
- Update contact details
- Receive notices from the school
- Book appointments for Parents' Evenings
- Complete the annual data check (that's when we check emergency contacts etc).

Before you can access the many features parentsportal.scot has to offer, you **must** first have a **myaccount**. As this is all new and different schools will be at different stages of adopting parentsportal.scot we have devised FAQs and guidance documents that should answer all your questions and help you through the process. You will see four options and should select the one most relevant to you:

- I don't have an iPayimpact account or MyAccount
- I have an iPayimpact account but no MyAccount
- I have a MyAccount but no iPayimpact account
- I have an iPayimpact account and a MyAccount

Once you have done this you can then register for parentsportal.scot and you will be able to link to your child(ren) and gain access to the services listed above. Please note that in order to link to your child(ren), the data you provide during registration must match the most up-to-date data that we hold for them.

The FAQs on the Council website should give you all the information you need to register

but should you need any further assistance please contact the school office.

We hope that parentsportal.scot and its services will become an integral part of you and your child's school experience.
