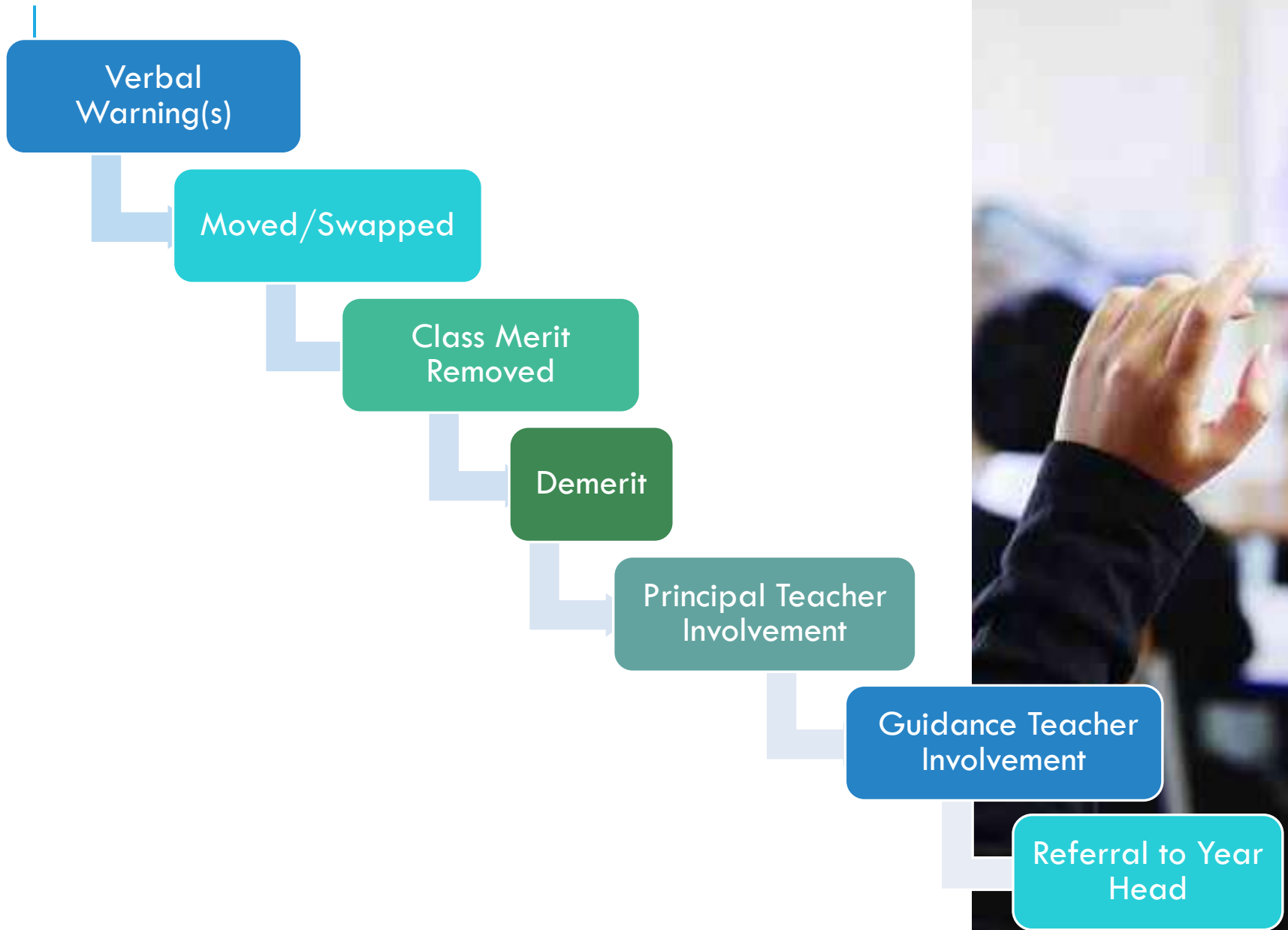

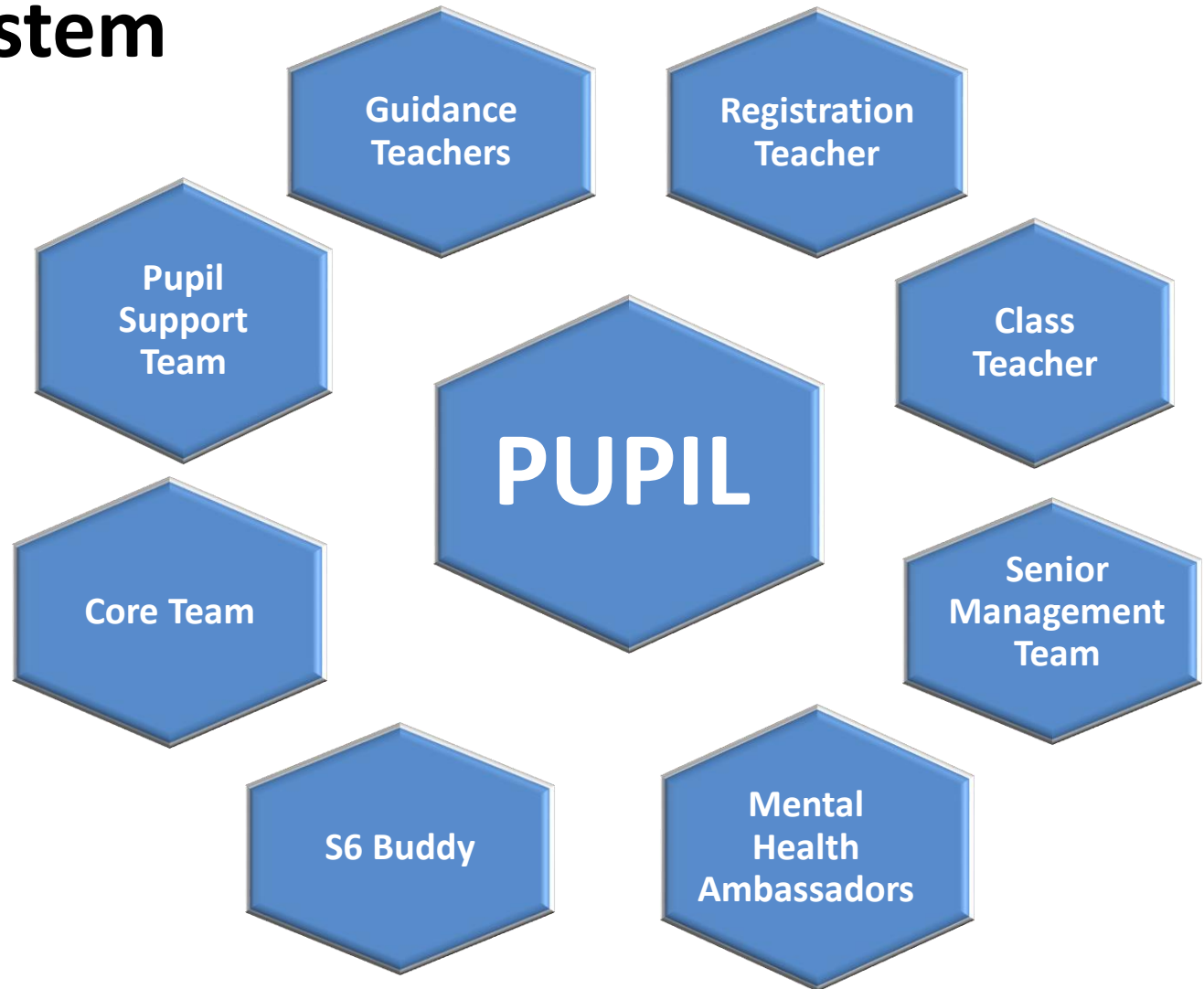

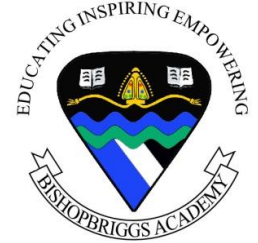

- Learning Support Resource space if required.



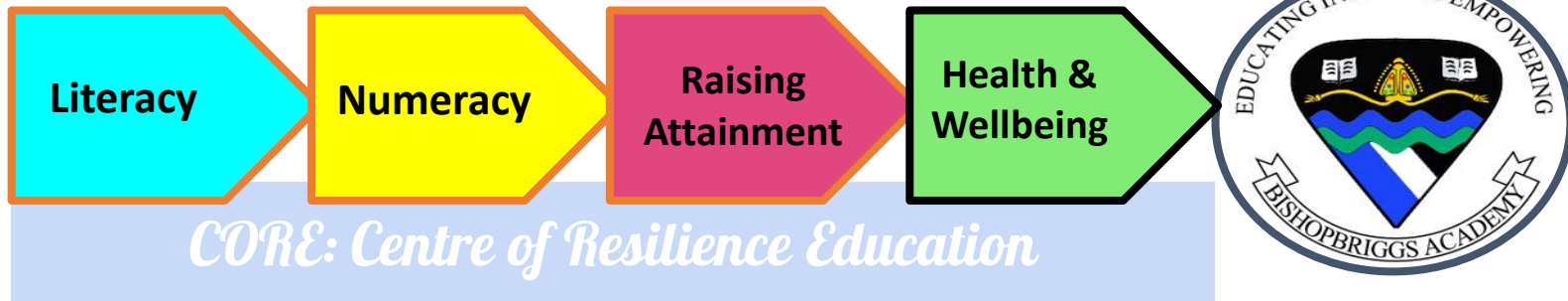

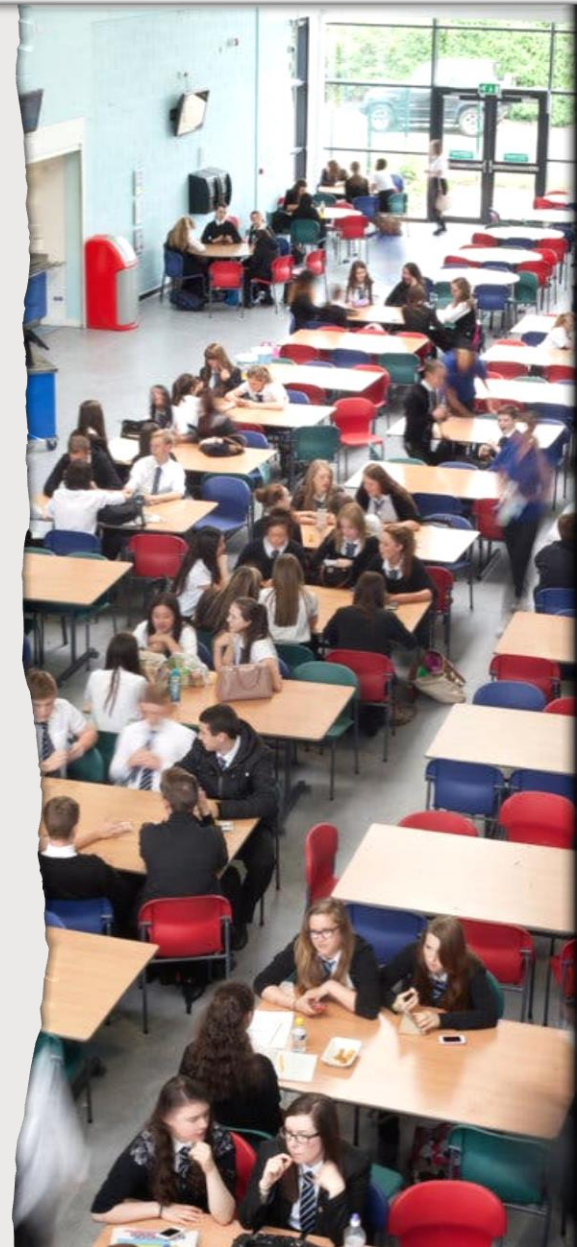




Cashless Catering
