As part of Curriculum for Excellence, every young person is entitled to support in moving into a positive and sustained destination (Further Education, Higher Education, employment or training). It is our task to enable pupils to make informed decisions about their future.

We are aware that as your son or daughter approaches their final year at Bishopbriggs Academy, there will no doubt be some uncertainty about what the future holds. Deciding on the best course of action in an attempt to arrive at a positive destination can be difficult if you are unaware of the support and opportunities available.
