Two Minute Termly Focus — Retrieval Practice

The Principle of Retrieval Practice: Asking pupils to retrieve information is a crucial learning technique because the act of retrieval further embeds learning into the long term memory. If we do not ask students to retrieve learning from their memory it is likely to be forgotten and learning is unlikely to develop into a deeper level of understanding over time.

Storage Strength verses Retrieval Strength: Author and teacher Kate Jones refers to the key concepts of SS and RS. Knowing the difference between these helps us as practitioners to plan retrieval practice opportunities that are effective and meaningful.


