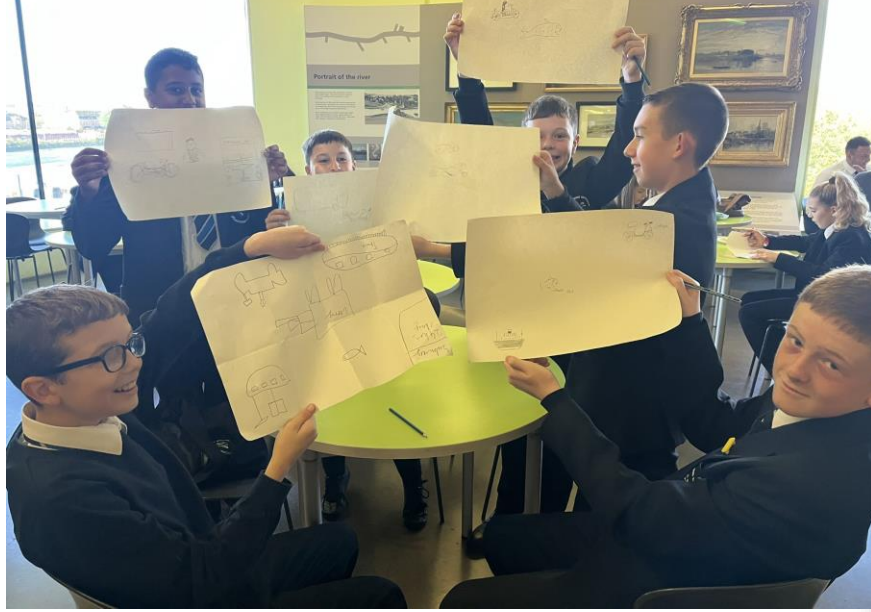

# We Take Pride In Our Facilities

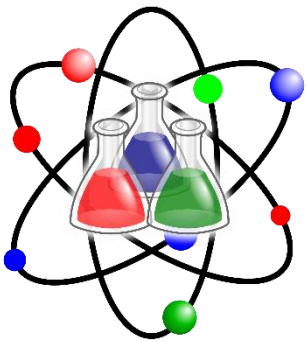
- interactive boards in every classroom
